# Part 2: Agenda items

- 4. New Ways of Working Blizard building project plan
  - This item took the whole time of the meeting as it was a priority item.
  - Presentation of the New Ways of Working (NWOW) project plan for the Blizard building was
    delivered by CF and it was followed by discussion including questions to GG and RW. Slides shared
    by CF will be uploaded by MCB to BEB March folder after meeting.
  - To accommodate PHURI (Precision Health Research University Research Institute), Institute of
    Dentistry and Blizard Institute growth within the Blizard building a workplace survey was carried
    out in October 2022. Main areas highlighted were lack of collaboration, meeting rooms/break up
    space for private and/or confidential conversations, lack of natural light and need to reduce noise
    level.

- MC confirmed that according to QM card access an average of 40% staff are onsite daily.
- Options considered for ground floor and first floor regarding bookable shared office space and write up areas were discussed.
- CF reported that a Change Manager will be appointed.
- MC asked for electronic lab books and scanning service to be implemented prior to project implementation.
- Centre's will be allocated desks in "villages" to be managed via Centre Leads. FF reported that there are 34 spaces on first floor for Dentistry and they are not enough for the 40 students they have in total (Master students and Implant students for PG projects in summer). MC suggested to have a dedicated space for Master students in Abernethy bldg. (e.g Biochemistry have staff in the Blizard lab but offices in the Abernethy)
- Requests during discussion emphasized the need to explain the rationale behind the project to bring people on board to this change, the importance of break out spaces to build up a sense of support and community for example. Smaller desks are preferred in the ground floor area so there is more space for break out areas.
- Storage space for data: non-clinical data could be stored in Wingate or Abernethy buildings and clinical data in some designated offices in the Blizard. This will need to be explored in more detail.
- A project board group will be constituted. MC suggested Centre leads and Research leads to meet with CF.
- Timeline: RW reported that this project is planned to be finished this calendar year with a phased development starting on first floor of the building with a 12-14 week programme to do the work onsite.
