

## ArtNeuro: Sci/Art Exhibition

ArtNeuro was a 4 day, interactive event based in London, bringing together the visual arts and neuroscience through an exhibition of original artworks, talks and workshops.

The central event was an exhibition of artwork and installations featuring pieces formed from the result of 4 month collaborations between 16 pairs of artists and neuroscientists.

The programming also involved workshops and talks, including an interactive memory experiment, knit-a-neuron sessions, panel discussion, a brain-themed poetry evening, a “synaesthesia” cocktail night and SciBar talks.

### Results

The main exhibition attracted over 1000 visitors over the short run, as well as selling out all 270 places on workshops, live talks and debates.

The exhibition received positive feedback from visitors, and the project has built a sizeable and growing web-presence.

### Future plans:

The exhibition has toured to Edinburgh as part of the International Science Festival and will return with new collaborations as ‘Art Necro’.

The projects live on through the artists and scientists continuing to collaborate on their own individual projects. Some of these have not only produced further artwork, but also useful tools, resources and methods for the researchers themselves.
