# What is the AF MOS

- To review patients identified with AF
- Annual Review
- To ensure that all AF patients with a CHADVASC2 score of 2 or more are prescribed an anticoagulant

### Examination

For recording examinations (BP, height, BMI etc.) please use the main page.

If the patient is on an anti-platelet or anti-coagulant, please offer a Gastro-intestinal protector. Unless it is already prescribed.

### Atrial Fibrillation

**QOF Target:** If patient is on anticoagulation with scores 2 or more, however consider anticoagulation for anyone with a **score of 1 or more** unless Female <65yrs with no other risk factors.
