



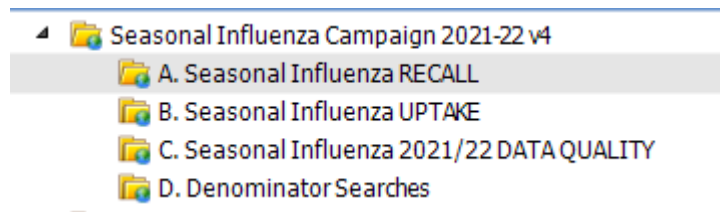
CEG Fact File: Seasonal Flu Campaign 2021-22

Protecting vulnerable patients from flu is still very important this year in the continuing light of Covid-19. This document outlines the CEG resources available to help you protect your patients and meet your targets.

Searches

Our searches to support the seasonal flu campaign are located in your CEG practice support folder, under 'Immunisation':

IMMUNISATION >> Seasonal Influenza Campaign 2021-22 v4



They include:

A. Recall – for call/recall

- These are split by eligibility cohort.
- They exclude patients who are already vaccinated or who have declined/not given consent for vaccination this flu season.
- Note that school-age children will generally be vaccinated at school unless they are in an at-risk category, but they can be vaccinated opportunistically at the practice.

B: Uptake – to monitor your progress

- CEG publishes a weekly Flu dashboard using this data. Dashboards are available on the password protected area of our website – please ask your Practice Manager or CEG facilitator for details.

C: Data quality – to identify coding issues that could affect payment

- Use these searches to identify patients where flu vaccination has been coded as a problem, has been coded more than once, or an incorrect code has been used so it will not contribute to payment or cover.
- We have included searches to identify patients deemed suitable for vaccination by a clinician, where the code 'Needs influenza vaccination - SNOMED 185903001' has been entered in their record. This code will be picked up by CQRS to ensure payment but will not count for cover.
- There is also a search for patients eligible because they are coded as living with an immunocompromised person.



PCN DES: Impact & Investment Fund flu indicators 2020-21

The three flu indicators - VI-01, VI-02 and VI-03 - will continue to be monitored and remunerated under the current Investment and Impact Fund (IIF).

- The cohorts for eligibility differ slightly between the IIF Direct Enhanced Service (DES) and the Seasonal Flu Enhanced Service. For IIF, they do not include as many chronic diseases and they exclude patients who have been invited twice.
- Please ensure you use the **recall** searches in the Seasonal Influenza Campaign for recall, not searches designed for monitoring performance.
