


Seasonal Flu Campaign Fact File: 2020-21



Housebound and special priority groups, such as carers, care home residents and pts with LD are included separately as these may follow a different pathway

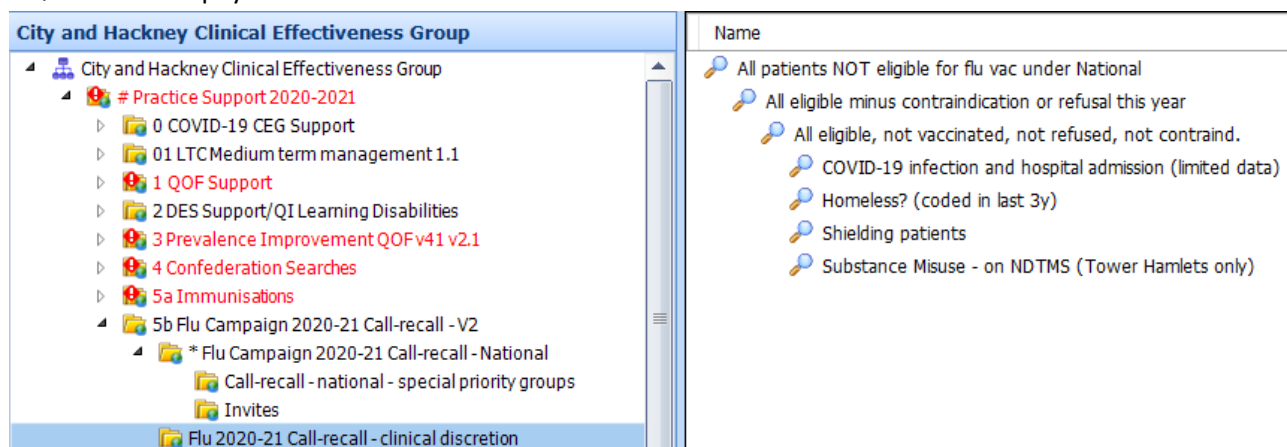

In C&H the District Nurse service has offered to vaccinate all housebound patients, however you may want to vaccinate some of these yourself. To indicate who you want the DN's to visit please enter **referred to District Nurse** Snomed 308436005 to each applicable patient. **Please complete this task by 18th September 2020.** Please Note the CEG will send a centrally compiled list direct to the DN service via a secure NHS account.

Locally eligible or discretionary this is a group of patients with significant health risk factors who do not fall into the main cohorts. It includes patients who have been admitted to hospital for Covid-19 or who were on the shielded list. Although vaccinating this cohort will not contribute to your overall target **you can be recompensed for this activity**. The accuracy of this data is subject to certain caveats such as receiving post Covid discharge summaries so clinical judgement is paramount.

Enter the code **Needs influenza vaccination SNOMED** 185903001 (was 90X4 in Read codes) this will be picked up by CQRS to ensure payment.

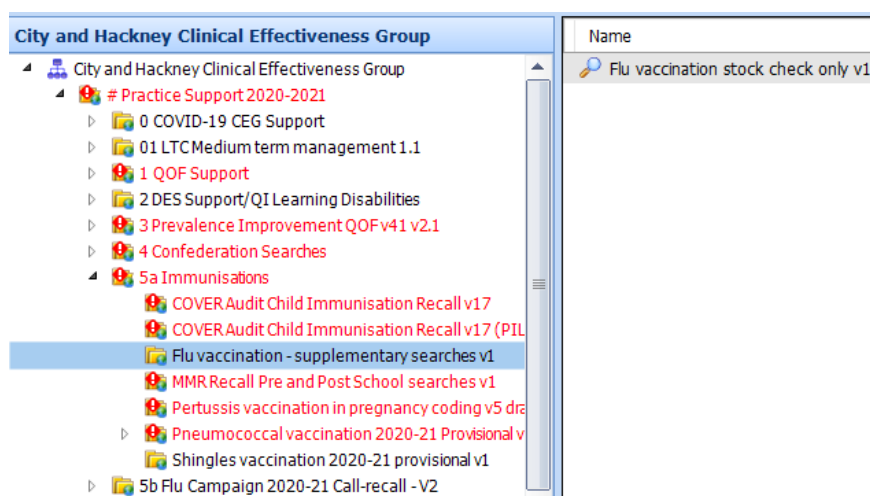


Other Groups – Please note we have not included **50 to 64 yr.** olds yet, you will not be expected to begin this group until November /December and subject to sufficient vaccine stock.

We have not included **school age children** as Vaccine UK are responsible. Please bear this in mind when reviewing your targets as their final inclusion may change your achievement levels when reported via Immform.

Ethnicity – Most of you are aware of the higher Covid risks factors associated with Black and Minority Ethnicity Groups, it's vital we ensure such patients receive as full a protection as possible and CEG have developed protocols and a zap template to help you quickly record this when offering flu vaccines. A complete data set prevents gaps in care.

Stock monitoring to assist you in managing your stock we have created a search which reports **all** patients you have issued a flu vaccine to whether they fall into any eligible category or not.



Shingles /Pneumococcal - CEG have updated the adult imms template so that it highlights if someone needs a shingles or pneumococcal vaccine as well as the flu jab.
