

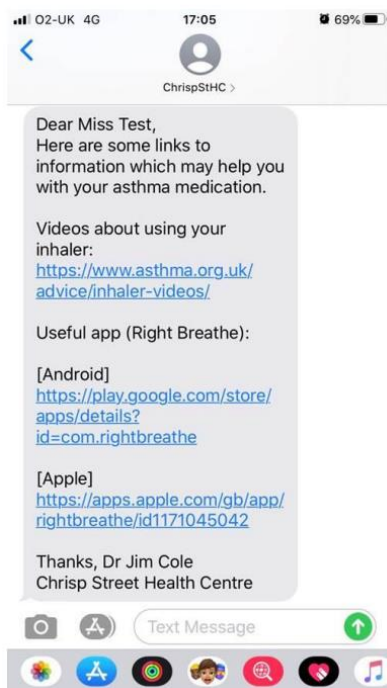
## Send asthma resources to your patient by text message

### Setting up your Practice **accuRx** Patient SMS Templates

Many local practices are now using accuRx Chain to send simple messages and links to patients.

We have devised some sample templates to copy into your own practice library, so your clinicians can easily send invitations for asthma reviews and links to further asthma information.

#### Example Text Message



This message gives the patient links which they can click to navigate to the Asthma UK website and download the Right Breathe smart phone app.

#### Instructions

1. Open the accuRx menu by clicking on the circle with your initials inside on the green accuRx toolbar.



2. Select 'Manage Practice' from the menu.
3. Select 'Manage Templates' in the web browser window.
4. Click 'Create New' in the '[name of your organisation] Templates' tab.
5. Insert an appropriate name for the template in the 'Title' box.
6. Copy and paste the sample text below into the message body box.

## Sample Text

You can copy and paste the following text into your templates and amend them to suit your practice.

### Patient Invitation for Asthma Review

We have noticed that you have been requesting a lot of blue reliever asthma inhalers recently. This may be a sign that your asthma is not as well controlled as it should be. Please book an appointment with a practice nurse for an asthma review.
