Who is eligible and in which order

9 priority cohorts – decided by the JCVI & listed in the Green Book

Priority group	Risk group
1	Residents in a care home for older adults Staff working in care homes for older adults
2	All those 80 years of age and over Frontline health and social care workers
3	All those 75 years of age and over
4	All those 70 years of age and over Clinically extremely vulnerable individuals (not including those under 16 years of age)
5	All those 65 years of age and over
6	Adults aged 16 to 65 years in an at-risk group (Table 3)
7	All those 60 years of age and over
8	All those 55 years of age and over
9	All those 50 years of age and over

Clinically extremely vulnerable

Or very high risk of complications from covid, or CEV, or shielding.

This group just became much bigger because of Qcovid

What are the risk factors in QCovid? <https://digital.nhs.uk/coronavirus/risk-assessment>

Issues identifying who is eligible

- Health and social care workers – coding issues. No call required
- Care home – coding issues.
- Covid high risk – easily identified
- Covid moderate risk – Until very recently no business rules, so open to interpretation. CEG adopted a ‘flu plus’ model based on the Green Book narrative. Now we have updated to new PRIMIS rules – less patients included

Why should I use CEG searches not others' (EMIS library for example)?



1. Designed with the needs of our local patients in mind
2. Avoid occupation data errors
3. Include ALL Learning Disabilities and Epilepsy patients
4. Include patients with Hx of PE or DVT
5. Provide a way to call pregnant women if at high risk
6. Provide csv files for AccuBook
7. Approved by NEL COVVAC group

Managing hesitancy and deferrals

Pinnacle will enter a declined code in the patient record in situations where there was not actual 'declined' but temporary hesitation for example.

New CEG template will facilitate the process at the practice and we will provide extra searches to follow them up

Second Vaccination Deferred

SARS-CoV-2 (severe acute respiratory syndrome coronavirus 2) vaccination second dose declined

Text

Reason for deferral -

AND

Treatment delay - patient choice

11-Feb-2021



If patient **defers** remember to:

- Signpost to information
- Advise how to book if change their mind
- Offer 1:1 clinical discretion
- Advise appointment will be offered again some time in the future

3. Attempted contact 3 times no response

Record each time you have attempted to invite the patient, after 3 unsuccessful attempts you may record as declined.

4. Declined

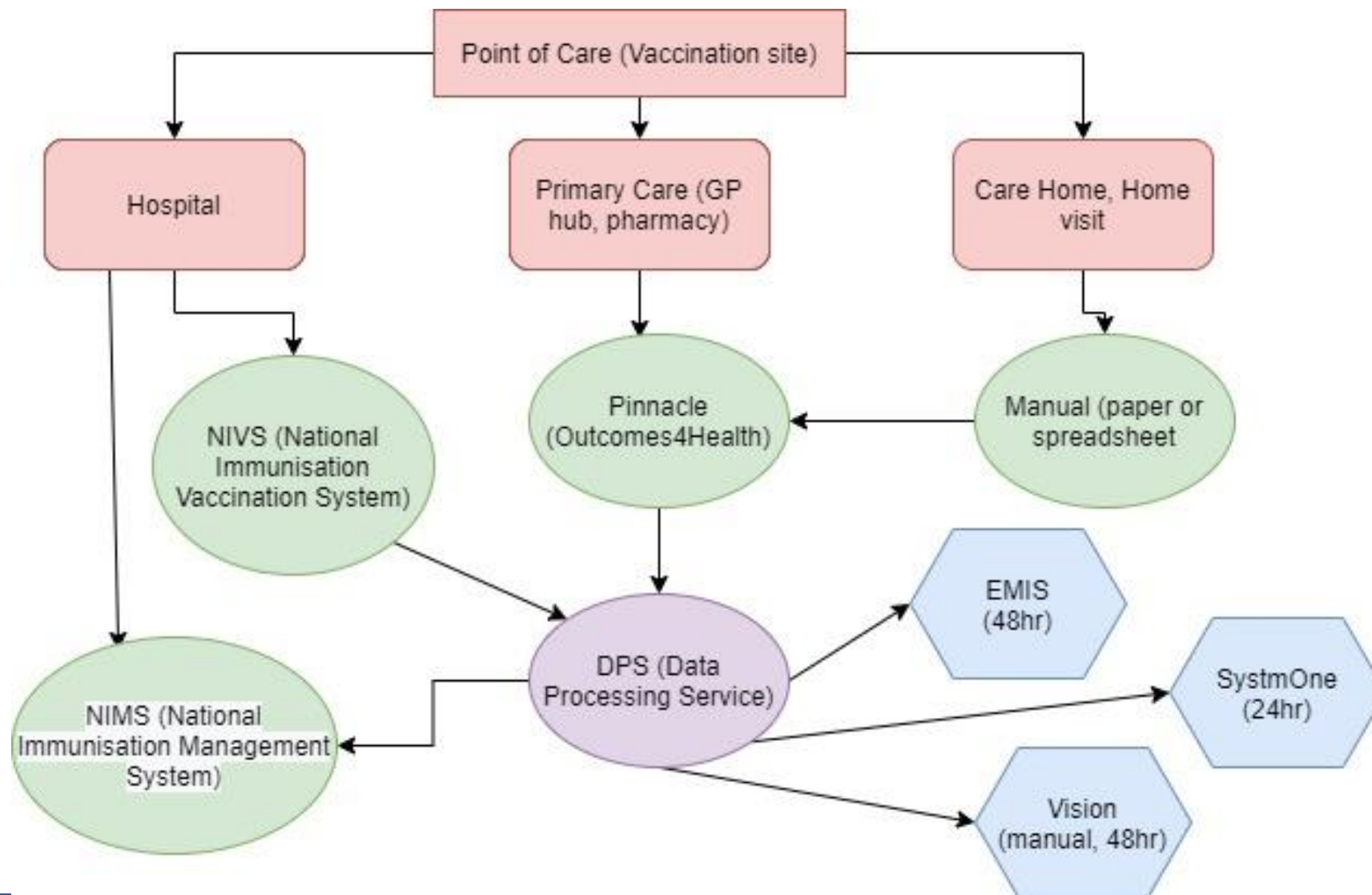
If patient declines to have the vaccination code below.

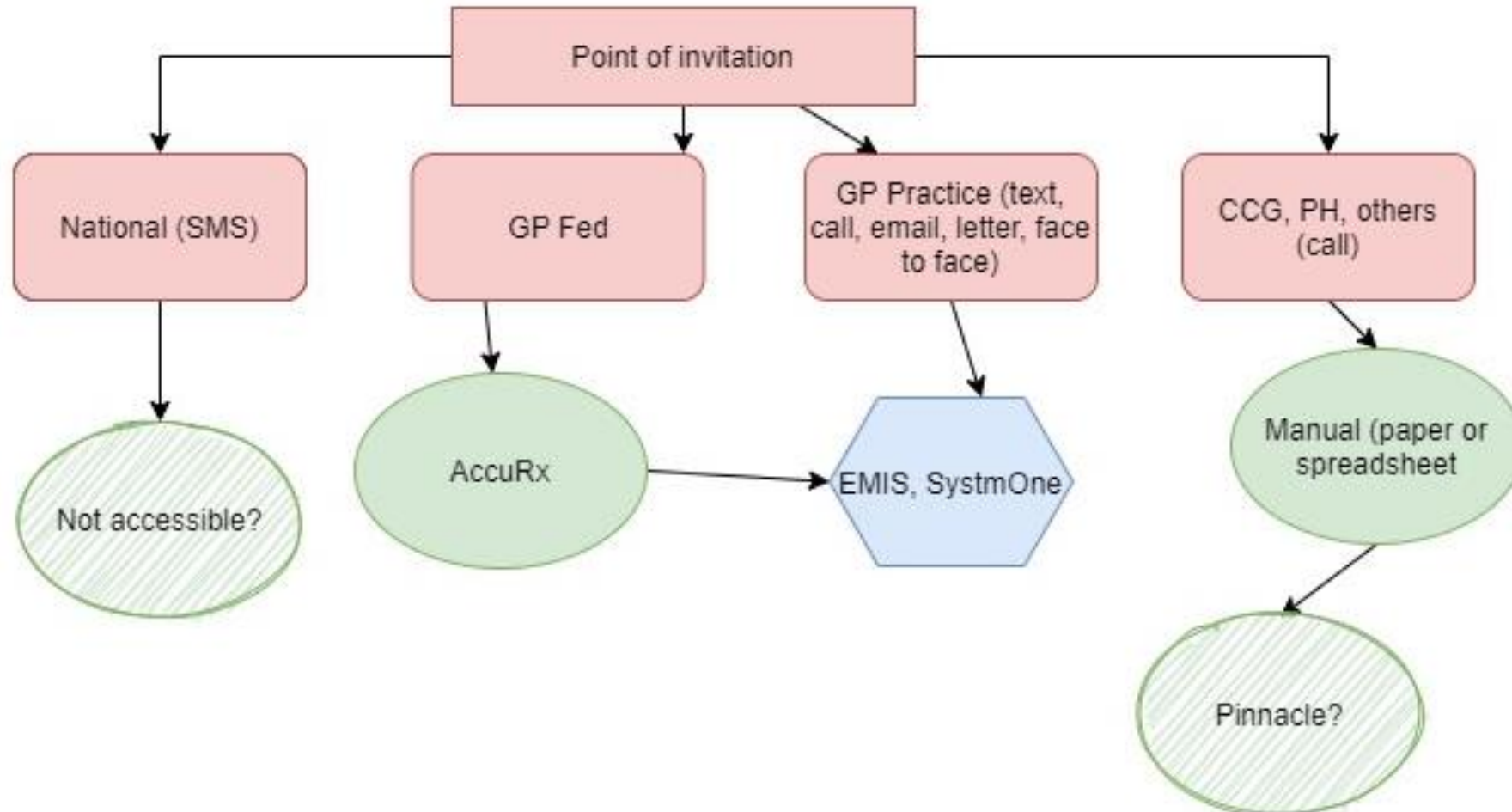

What you need to do now

1. Have you done all your over 70s?
2. What are the local arrangements for the new members of cohort 4?
3. Check your cohort 6 (Covid moderate risk) and if you need to add any patients by clinical discretion, add code:
i1240601000000108 | High priority for SARS-CoV-2 (severe acute respiratory syndrome coronavirus 2) vaccination
4. Check if your housebound register is up to date
5. Check if your pregnancy register is up to date

Ethnicity & wider determinants of health



Wider determinants of health: housing, income, literacy, social isolation
– massively influence health outcomes

New CEG template helps you record your conversations with the patient

Ethnicity recording – now statutory requirement - biggest gaps are in
new registrations and the under 5s. Self-reported.

Black Caribbean – strong predictor of vaccine hesitancy

CEG offers: template page, alerts, search, NEL wide analysis
