## IT accounts and Wi-Fi

You will be given your Queen Mary IT account details when you enrol. You will need this to log into your [emails](#) and [QMplus](#) – the online learning environment. Once you arrive, you can connect to the University Wi-Fi by looking for the Eduroam network and entering your Queen Mary email (eg [1234@qmul.ac.uk](#)) and password.

During Welcome Week, you can find the IT team in the libraries at the Mile End and Whitechapel campuses to help with any questions you have about your IT account and getting online.
