### Why become a PG Law Mentor?

- Involve yourselves with the work of QMUL Postgraduate Law School.
- Offer students insights into new or different career advancement approaches.
- Reflect on your own career progression.
- Gain recognition for your skills, knowledge, and contribution as a mentor, developing your professional profile.
- Raise the profile of your organisation among legal professionals, staff members and students.
- Support postgraduate law international students in understanding the UK legal profession, and qualifications.
- Expand your global professional network with other legal practitioners.

The Postgraduate Law Mentoring Programme is a professional development pathway aimed to support postgraduate law students in their career development through exploring career ideas, ideally in the legal sector or another industry with the guidance of a legal practitioner.

**To become a PG Law Mentor, you must have:**

- Previously completed a law programme (e.g., Bachelor of Laws)
- A genuine interest in helping students improve their employment prospects.
- Availability to meet with a student at least one hour per month for six months.
- The ability to provide a student with first-hand insight into your current profession and industry.

**Please note:** You are required to attend an online induction session. More information about the induction session will be sent out after the registration closes.
