

- What is a visibility rule?
- If a patient is on the Asthma, Diabetes and Heart Failure register, only these relevant pages will show.





The importance of using templates

Consistency in data entry

Example:

Dietary advice
Diet in pregnancy advice
Osteoporosis - dietary advice
Menopause: dietary advice
Dietetic goal - provide supportive advice
Intervention for risk to health associated with overweight and obesity, advice about diet and physical activity
Intervention for risk to health associated with overweight and obesity, advice about diet and physical activity, consider drugs
Intervention for risk to health associated with overweight and obesity, advice about diet and physical activity, consider drugs, consider surgery
High energy diet advice
Dietary advice for food allergy
Lifestyle advice regarding diet

Saves Time

Rather then typing in the consultation section, you tick the boxes

ie. Exercise advice – tick box Dietary advice – tick box

Templates allow you to see the previous entries of data



This is a useful function especially for Blood Test eg. Diabetes HbA1c, you will be able to identify immediately if the HbA1c hasn't been carried out within the relevant timeframe.
