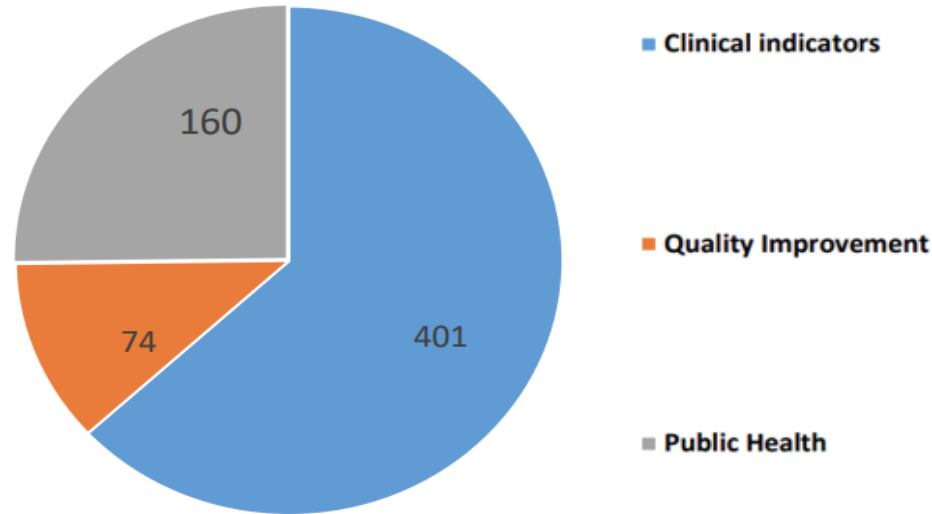

[AST007]: Asthma with review in last 12 months

Includes:

- Asthma review code
- Self-management plan
- Asthma control test score
- Number of exacerbations in past year



[AST008]: Asthma 19y or under with smoking status/exposure recorded

- E.g. Accurx florey smoking SMS

Exposure to smoking codes:

- **Passive smoker or Exposed to tobacco smoke**
- **Not a passive smoker or No known exposure to tobacco smoke**

[AST0011]: Asthma with objective tests recorded

- Spirometry **AND** another objective test – 3m before to 6m after diagnosis
- Spirometry Service Unavailable? – “**QOF (Quality and Outcomes Framework) diagnostic spirometry service not available**”
- Referred for spirometry? – “**Referral for spirometry reversibility test**”

 - Patients diagnosed with cancer in the last 2m
 - CAN005 Cancer diagnosed last 2m, no support discussion [CALL]
 - Patients diagnosed with cancer in the last 11m
 - CAN004 Cancer diagnosed last 11m, no cancer care review [CALL]

[CHOL001]: Patients with CHD/PAD/Stroke/CKD on statin or lipid-lowering therapy

- Prescribe statin
- Prescribe lipid-lowering therapy AND record statin allergy/contraindicated/not tolerated

[CHOL002]: Patients with CHD/PAD/Stroke with non-HDL cholesterol <2.5 or LDL <1.8

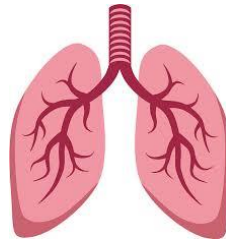

[COPD014]: COPD and MRC \geq 3 and referred for pulmonary rehabilitation

Wording changed to measure “**referrals made**” not “**offers for referrals**”

- patient declines – **Pulmonary rehabilitation declined**
- previously attended rehab – **Pulmonary rehabilitation programme completed**
- service not available – **QOF (Quality and Outcomes Framework) pulmonary rehabilitation service not available**



[DEP004]: New diagnosis of depression eligible for a review

- Review 10 to 56 days after diagnosis
- Depression monitoring codes to record invitations.

Note:

- Patients with different depression codes
- Depression code recorded as New or First episode instead of Review

QOF Mental Health Check

- 5 individual health check indicators
 - Blood Pressure
 - BMI
 - Alcohol consumption
 - Hba1c or glucose
 - Lipids

AND




- **[MH021]:** Overall health check indicator – 5 elements plus **smoking status**

Mental Health Check PCAs:

- BP – **Blood pressure procedure declined**
- BMI – **Body weight measurement declined OR Unsuitable for body weight measurement**
- Alcohol consumption – **Declines to state current alcohol consumption**
- Hba1c/glucose – **Blood glucose test declined**
- Lipids – **Cholesterol test declined**
- Smoking – **Declined to give smoking status**

[MH021]: At least one decline code **AND** all 6 elements coded as either done or declined to exclude a patient.

Name

- SMI Register
 - SMI excluding in Remission
 - 1. Complete Physical Health Check (incl. 6 components)
 - 2. Incomplete Physical Health Check (incl. 6 components)
 - Missing Criteria for 6 physical health checks
 - Alcohol Status (12mths)
 - BMI Recorded (12mths)
 - BP Recorded (12mths)
 - Chol or QRISK (12mths)
 - HbA1c / Blood Glucose (12mths)
 - Smoking status (12mths or never smoked ever)

Medication codes for some Anticoagulants, Statins, ACEi/ARBs and beta-blockers not being picked up. This affects:

- Anticoagulants: AF008, CHD005 and STIA007
- Statin: CHOL001, DM022 and DM023
- ACEi/ARB: DM006 and HF003
- Beta-blockers: HF006

[CHD005]: CHD taking anti-platelet or anti-coagulant

[STIA007]: Non-haemorrhagic stroke or TIA taking anti-platelet or anti-coagulant

Generic warfarin, aspirin, apixaban and dipyridamole are not being picked up

Can use SNOMED codes:

- **Aspirin therapy**
- **Advice about taking aspirin**
- **Warfarin prophylaxis**
- **Clopidogrel prophylaxis**

QOF Invitation Codes

Be Aware:

LTC invitation codes: 2 invite codes recorded at least 7 days apart will remove a patient from eligible denominator

Overall invite code: **“QOF (Quality and Outcomes Framework) quality indicator-related care invitation”** excludes patients across disease searches

QOF Cervical Smears

[CS005]: 25-49yrs adequate smear within last 3yrs and 6m

[CS006]: 50-64yrs adequate smear within last 5yrs and 6m

- One invite sent centrally
- Practice to send up to two invites

PCAs:

- **Excepted from cervical screening quality indicator – no response to 3 invitations**
- **Cervical smear not indicated**
- **Screening for malignant neoplasm of cervix declined**



[SMOK002]: Chronic disease and smoking status recorded

- E.g. Accurx florey smoking SMS

[SMOK004]: Current smokers with offer of support

[SMOK005]: Chronic disease and smoking advice given

- Send advice/support text

Codes:

- **Smoking cessation advice**
- **Referral to stop-smoking clinic**
- **Referral to smoking cessation declined**



QOF Childhood Immunisations

[VI001]: 3rd DTaP dose given before 8 months

[VI002]: 1st MMR dose given aged 12-18 months

[VI003]: Aged 1-5 with 2 MMR doses & DTaP/IPV booster

- 3.- Aged 4 and a half years - need to complete preschool vacc course

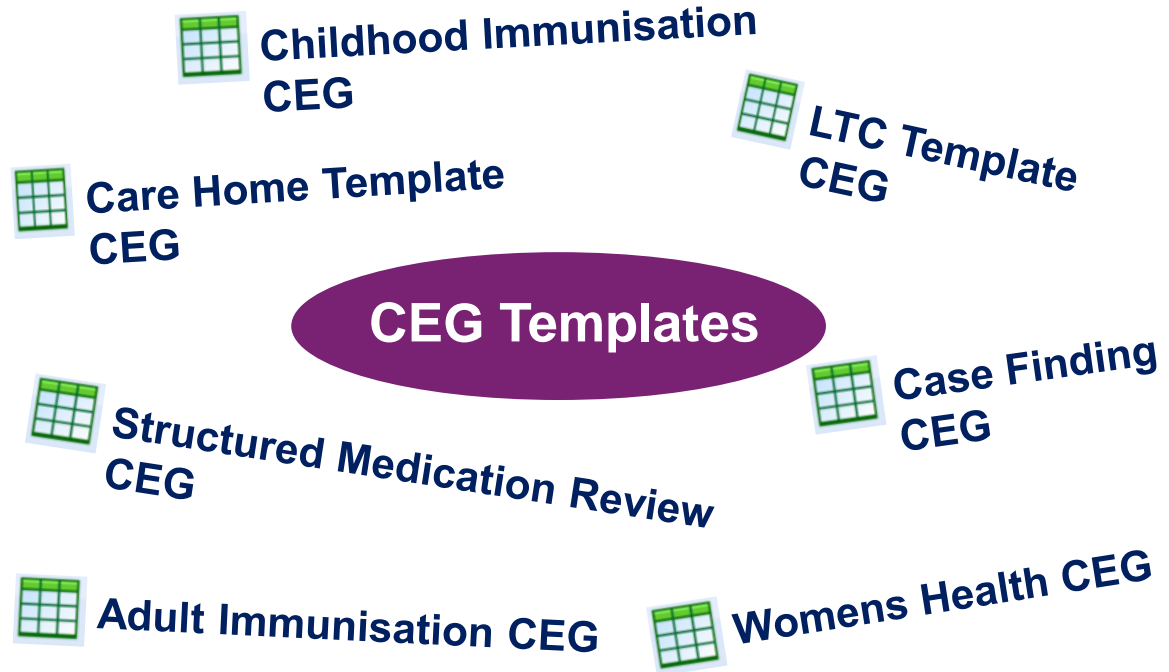

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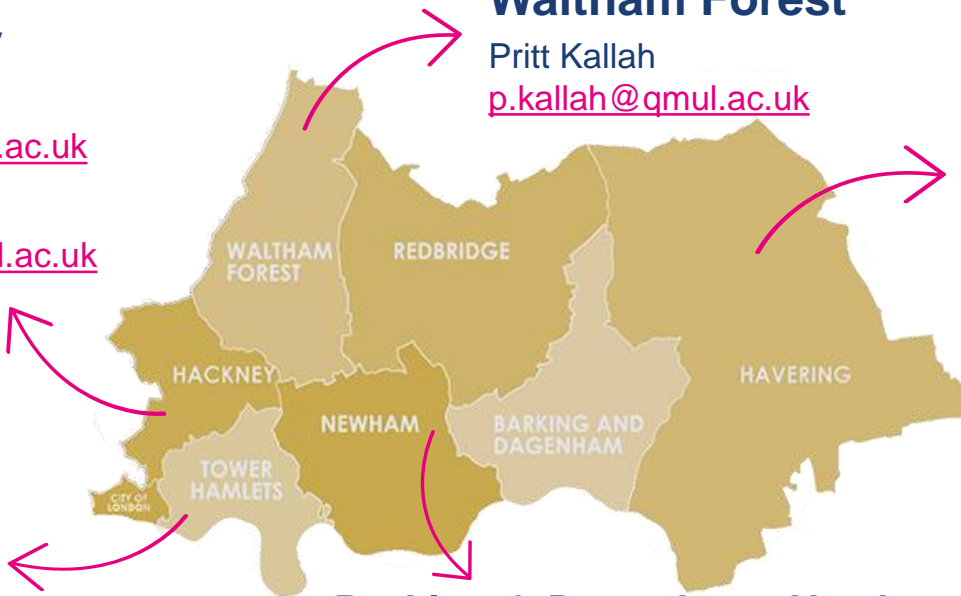
