


We held group discussions and interviews with members of the community to explore their experiences with vaccinations.

WHAT FEATURES WILL THIS TOOL HAVE?

Messages will be personalized

Texts will be translated to other languages

Messages will contain links to webpages with further information

Links to informational videos will be embedded in the messages.

EVALUATING THE TOOL

We will be recruiting six GP practices to test the feasibility of the messaging tool.

Patients from the six GP practices from Tower Hamlets and Newham will either receive the Patient Engagement Tool or routine care to understand the usefulness and suitability of the tool.
