Consider these scenarios in your groups - do you think anyone has broken the law in these cases? Why? Please note that these are all hypothetical situations!

Timothy is going out with Kylie. Timothy breaks up with her because he is still in love with his old girlfriend, Lily. Kylie is heartbroken and upset, and very angry at Timothy because he told her Lily was out of the picture. She decides to photoshop Timothy's face on a naked man and sends it to everyone in the school because she is so angry.

Does it matter that there was a reason and she was angry? Why do you think that?

Molly and Callum were together for 3 years. During this time, Molly sent Callum intimate images consensually throughout their relationship. After 3 years they broke up. Molly did not ask Callum to delete the images. A year later, Callum sends naked pictures of Molly to his friend, saying "I really want to get back together with her, but I know she hates me and doesn't want anything to do with me".

Does it matter that he was sending it to a friend as part of asking for his advice on how to reignite the relationship? Why do you think that?

Dhillon and Kate are in a relationship, and are intimate with each other in his office. Dhillon has a camera in his office because there are lots of sensitive documents which mean they have high office security. Kate consented to the sexual activity in the office and because she also works there, she knew there was a camera in the office. Dhillon later tries to access the camera footage to delete it from the security files, however, he accidentally sends it to the whole office floor.

Does it matter that it was an accidently sent? Does it matter that Kate knew the camera was in the office? Why do you think that?

Victoria hears that her ex-boyfriend David has been seeing her friend, Rebecca. Victoria is so angry at David, that she messages him saying "If you don't stop seeing her, I'm going to send your pictures, you know the ones, to all your friends." Victoria does not actually have any intimate images of David, as she deleted them when they broke up. David panics and breaks up with Rebecca like Victoria asked.

Does it matter that there were no actual images in existence? Does it matter that they were previously shared with consent? Why do you think that?
