**Induction Week Information:** 18 – 24 January 2021 (Online)

Eventbrite registration will open from 15 December 2020.

✚ '**Programme Induction**' – for all students

This event will be led by the Programme Director and here you will receive your 'Student Pack'.

For those students not travelling to London and are participating online, your 'Student Pack' will be available to download from the Induction page (QMplus).

Please register for the Programme Induction that you are registered on. Students who are **not** registered on the programmes listed below with an '\*\*' should register for the '**Programme Induction: LLM, Wednesday 20 January 2021**'.

\*Law and Finance (MSc), Law and Economics (LLM), Regulation and Compliance (LLM/MA), ESCP, Dual LLM Commercial Law (London/Singapore), FLEXI LLM/PgDip\* - These programmes have their own Programme Induction scheduled.

✚ '**Webinar**' Programme of Study - Academic Guidance (Online) – for all students

- This will include introductions to some colleagues teaching on your programme of study
- Provide unique key points, up and coming events that may be of interest to the students, followed by a Q&A
- 'Free Choice' - Students that wish to take up to 60 credits outside of their programme may also attend these sessions. If a session clashes with your own programme of study then you must prioritise attending your programme of study session 'live' and view the recording of the session relevant to your 'free choice' in your own time.

✚ '**Programme of Study - Networking Event**' (Online)

- These are for students who are studying on campus - offering an opportunity to meet fellow students and academic staff on their programme of study

### ✚ Assessment overview session

### ✚ Critical Thinking and Writing

The purpose of Critical Thinking and Writing in Law is three-fold. Firstly, it helps students who have been accepted on a conditional offer meet their language requirement. Second, it offers students with opportunities to deepen their understanding of the learning strategies required at postgraduate study. Lastly, it aspires to guide and assist students through the different stages of the writing process of their essays and dissertations.

### ✚ Library Events

- For the QM Library Event students should watch the pre-record lecture video before attending the Q&A on the day
- These sessions are repeated so please only attend one of each

- Introduction to Common Law (on campus only – limited places) – live stream is not available, however, a recording will be made available via the Induction QM+

### ✚ Careers Event

This event will introduce you to the PG Law Careers team, providing an overview of the specialist career support, events and opportunities made available to postgraduate law students throughout the year.

The session will explain how our PG Law Careers team can assist you with your career planning and it will outline the full programme of employer events, seminars and workshops designed to support employability

### ✚ qLegal Event

qLegal offers a diverse range of programmes combining technical knowledge of the law and the legal sector with developing practical skills required for professional practice. Taking part in qLegal increases your employability prospects and skills (develops professional ethics, gives context for academic studies) and enhances the experience as a postgraduate student at Queen Mary University of London

At the end of the Induction period, students will have to select their modules for the academic year ahead. We will open for module selection on or around 20 January 2021. **Students cannot pre-select modules before this date. If MySIS allows you to select before this date please note that ALL selections will be automatically REJECTED.**
