The School of Law has a £1,000 scholarship on offer for an exemplary student in the final year of a three or four year LLB.

Scholarship Benefits and Expectations

The successful applicant will be awarded £1,000. This scholarship may be held alongside other bursaries, scholarships and award packages.

Selection criteria

Applicants will be assessed on their application, but must also meet the following criteria:

- All second year modules passed with an overall average 2:1 grade (60-69%) or higher; and
- An attendance record of 90% or above.

Deadline to Apply	10am Thursday 5 January
Interviews	Shortlisted candidates will be invited to an online interview. Interviews will likely be on Wednesday 25 January 2023, but this is TBC
