Revenge porn is sharing private sexual images without the consent of the person in them.

**Revenge porn** is committed when a person uploads, publishes, shows or shares these images.

You don't have to be an ex to be guilty of **revenge porn**. The images don't even need to be pornographic.

**Example:**  
Taking a picture of your friend getting changed, and then sharing it, means you could be guilty.

# Think before you share!

**Revenge porn** can include:  
Photographs.  
Messages.  
Videos.  
Screen Shots.  
Emails.

**Think before you share.**  
Once an image is online it can go viral and you may never be able to remove it.

**Sharing images** more than once means you could be convicted of harassment and be detained for two years.

**Sharing is not cool or funny.**  
It is cruel and bullying.

## If you've been a victim, contact the police

**There is no excuse for sharing.**  
The victim is never to blame.

If you share, you'll end up here.

If you share, you **WILL** get a **criminal record** and this will affect your future.

**Example**  
Even showing your friends the image on your phone is considered an offence.
