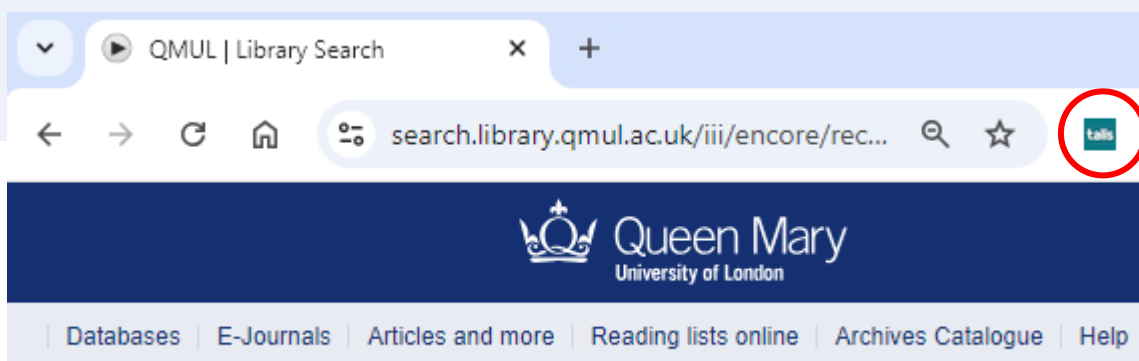
### Step 1.

[Login to Reading Lists Online](#) using your Queen Mary credentials

The first time you login, you'll need to create a profile – use your Queen Mary email address and set your profile to public.

### Step 2.

[Install the browser bookmarking extension](#) – this allows you to quickly capture information about books, articles, videos and many other resources to add to your list. Once active, it will appear as a green button to the right of your browser address bar, click to bookmark information on a webpage.



### Step 3.

[Create a new reading list](#) to add your resources to. You can add sections and organise your list as you go, and once you're ready to publish you can embed your list on QMplus.
