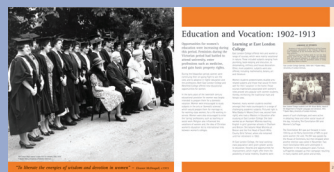
## Women at Queen Mary Celebrating women as students and teachers at Queen Mary, University of London

'Women at Queen Mary' tells the story of women at the College through the generations from 1850 to the present day. It reveals a fascinating history of women in higher education in the UK: from the struggle to gain access to study; the fight to learn on equal terms as men; the academic and cultural contributions which these women have made; and the inspiration they have provided to younger generations of female students.
