Requirements will mirror our IELTS requirements, for example: If the QM course requires 'IELTS 6.5 overall, with 6.0 in Writing, and 5.5 in each of the other components' – we expect students to have done at least the 'B2 Communicator test, and obtained an aggregate score of 152 out of 200 from the 4 components, with 35/50 in the Writing, and 33/50 in each of the other components.

The qualification should have been achieved no more than 2 years from the start date of your course. The qualification must include all four language skills: Listening, Reading, Writing and Speaking.
