- Two researchers from Bosnia and one from Colombia stayed in London for a 2- week residential visit, and presented at the global health seminar series about the context of mental health care in their countries.
- REDCap has gone live and data entry has begun.
- Ethics has been received at Campo Abierto in Bogotá, and recruitment here has begun for DIALOG+.
- Uganda has completed all 6-month follow ups at the control site.
- The DIALOG+ study in Peru has been registered on ISRCTN.
- Sana and Vicky visited Pakistan 22 – 26th July, and completed training and monitoring activities.
- Pakistan has finished recruitment for Family Involvement, and has nearly finished recruitment for DIALOG+, both interventions have begun.
