News

- Argentina has received its local ethics and we are now applying for QMUL ethics, so we should hopefully be able to begin the DIALOG+ intervention there soon.
- Colombia has finished recruitment at their last site Campo Abierto, and the DIALOG+ intervention should begin there soon.
- Prof Alma, our PI for Bosnia, presented GLOBE at the International Congress XVII Psychiatry conference of Bosnia and Herzegovina.
- Uganda has completed the first six-months of all interventions, and is now entering the flexible phase of the study with many participants keen to continue actively participating.
- We are working on our applications for the no-cost (up until March 2021) and costed extensions (up until July 2021) which are due to be submitted on the 7th November 2019.
- The Advisory Group has been consulted and is fully supportive of both the costed and non-cost extensions.
- Camilo Cabarique, the trial coordinator for Bogotá, spent time with the UK team in London for two weeks earlier this month.
- Vicky travelled to Bogotá w/c the 21st October to complete monitoring activities in Colombia.
