- The contracts for the costed and no-cost extension are currently being finalised and signed between NIHR and QMUL.
- The quarterly finance report (including the new project projections until July 2021) was submitted to the NIHR.
- The Statistical Analysis Plan has been finalized and signed off by most original partners. It will be shared with the new partners before they begin data analysis.
- Many participants are continuing to receive the interventions in Uganda during the flexible phase.
- Data entry and cleaning is ongoing at most sites.
- Argentina has begun recruitment and DIALOG+ sessions.
- A PI teleconference took place this month with the original partners, where it was decided that a paper writing week will be held around September 2020 in London.
- All original partners are working on their dissemination plans
