## Dear friend

You will see by the inclosed that I must not publish the <u>Sermon<sup>1</sup></u> till I hear from the family. I beg therefore that you would take back those I sent you, or take the trouble to deliver the <u>alterations</u> I may have occasion to make in it.<sup>2</sup>

It is evident that Mr Robinson,<sup>3</sup> tho an unitarian, did not wish to incur the <u>odium</u> of it with all his old friends.

I want to know how Mr Dodson<sup>4</sup> goes on with his translation of the Prophets. I stick close to my part, and hope to have finished all that is <u>essential</u> before you come, at the end of the next month, or the middle of it. I do a certain quantity <u>per day</u>. We must make a point of dispatching the whole this year. I shall see Mr Belsham<sup>5</sup> and talk to him about his part. I shall also write to Mr Friend,<sup>6</sup> and give him any help that he may want. My method is to paste paper to the margin of a 4<sup>to</sup> Bible, and make the alterations there. This I think better, on every account, than to write the whole, and especially much easier to those who examin[e] it. Can you borrow for <u>me</u>[?] <u>Houbigant on Proverbs and Ecclesiastes</u>.<sup>7</sup> I mean his <u>version</u>.<sup>8</sup>

My wife is better than she was, and proposes to make an excursion of a fortnight to Nottingham, along with Mr Russell's<sup>9</sup> family, after you have been with us. I wish, therefore, that you would make your journey as soon as you conveniently can, but not to hurry yourself.

The <u>Hymns<sup>10</sup></u> are not quite ready, but will tomorrow or saturday. Yours & M<sup>rs</sup> Lindsey's most affectionately J Priestley
