

Hen – a timeline

1966

1994

hen is proposed by linguists as a short and useful alternative to e.g. hon eller han ("she or he")

1990s

> hen is introduced by activists in trans*gender and queer communities

ca 2000

> hen is used in more widespread queer and feminist magazines and newspapers

January 2012 start of the extensive media debate on hen, sparked by a children's book in which the author labels the main character
 a child – hen

2015

hen is included in Svenska Akademiens ordlista (the "Word list of the Swedish Academy")

2022

hen is widely used in different types of texts; has lost some (most?) of its activist connotations



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Research interest

- An analysis of the negative reactions that are provoked by hen in public comments in online forums.
 - What kind of discursive strategies are used in public comments on hen?
 - What view on language and gender is expressed in the reactions?

The corpus

Negative public comments in online forums

20122022

1289 comments 1122 comments

(989 from *Svenska Dagbladet*, (800 from *Aftonbladet*, 300 from *flashback*)

Method

Reisigl & Wodak (2016) types of discursive strategies:

- Nomination How are **persons**, objects, phenomena, events, processes and actions named and referred to linguistically?
- Predication What characteristics, qualities and features are attributed to social actors?
- Argumentation What arguments are employed in the discourse?
- Perspectivisation From what perspective are these nominations, attributions and arguments expressed?



Results

Nomination, predication, and perspectivisation strategies – Discursive construction and characterisation of social actors

US

 we, the people, ordinary people, normal people, normal humans, us normally functioning parents, and a few more

Hardly any changes over time

THEM

- the extreme feminists, the fanatic ultrafeminists, the feminist branch of the extreme left, the gender-confused feminists,
- the gender "researchers", the gender idiots, gender Taliban, the mentally disordered gender-extremists, gender-weirdos, the madmen of gender madness, the de-sexing advocates, impotent idiots,
- left-wing radicals, ultra-left extremists, the crazy socialists, Marxists, cultural Marxists, the social democrats,
- the PC-mafia, moralists, politicians, the elite, crazy transvestites, and many more

Types of reactions & argumentation strategies

- ignoration
- incomprehension
- denial
- warning
- trivialisation
- > ridicule
- insult (personal attack)

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- the established naming practices aren't discriminatory
- 2. trans*people do not exist
- 3. the pronoun *hen* doesn't exist

We already have *she* and *he* and those two pronouns include everyone!

There are only two biological sexes!

Men! And women! There are no hens!

Hen does not exist!! I looked in the dictionary.

Types of reactions & argumentation strategies

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- hen aims to discriminate against cis men
- 2. hen is introduced "from above" to restrict the freedom of speech
- 3. gender-neutral pronouns are unique to Sweden and harm Sweden's image

Obviously, you must be HBT or Muslim to be accepted in today's Sweden. As a white working heterosexual man, you don't get very far...

Note that this is government policy. Today, you cannot be successful professionally in the public sector if you do not conform to the dogmas of state feminism, where gender studies is the ideological engine.

View on the relation between language and gender


Now, they are also **attacking the order of nature**. New words and concepts are introduced in an attempt to create a new kind of human, a human without identity and gender. Poor children who are exposed to a **gender experiment with an uncertain outcome**. When will this madness end?

Summary

- Nomination, predication, and perspectivisation
 - "normal people" vs. "crazy ultra-feminists"
 - hardly any changes during the last 10 years
- Argumentation
 - denial and warning
 - > some smaller changes in the argumentation strategies during the last 10 years
- View on the relation between language and gender
 - 2012: an essential perspective on gender, but simultaneously a constructivist perspective on language; hen can change gender, gender norms, and society in a dangerous way
 - > 2022: hardly any discussions on the relation between language and gender



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
