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Intro & Aims

- Anti-hypertensive drugs are commonly used to lower BP
- However, there is substantial *inter-individual variability* in BP responses to anti-hypertensive drugs
- > It is hypothesised there could be genetic influences
- One goal of pharmacogenetics is Personalised Medicine, i.e. to aid in optimal treatment selection

AIM: To identify genetic variants which mediate the effect of antihypertensive drugs on blood pressure lowering response
